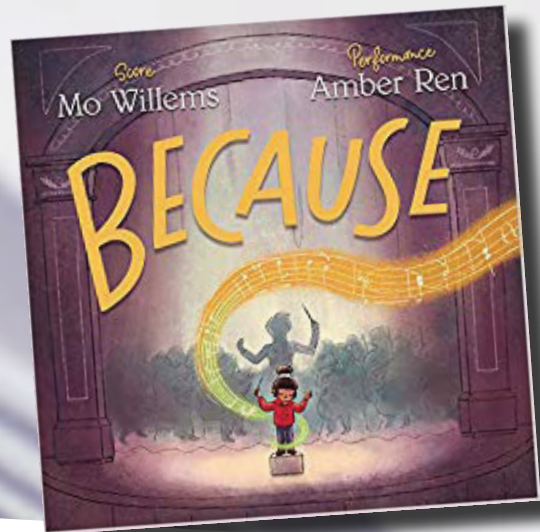

It is never too early to begin a lifelong love of reading. Cuddling up with a toddler on your lap and a Mo Willems *Elephant & Piggie* book in your hands is one of the greatest joys of life. You make it possible for parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, brothers, sisters and those who love children to have the resources to instill a love of reading in the hearts and minds of thousands of children in our community.

Children's minds are developing at a rapid pace, and it is so important that the right choices are available to fuel their constant quest for knowledge. Providing fun and engaging ways to learn is just one way the Library enhances the lives of children in our community.

More than 13,000 children, teens and families attended nearly 1,000 programs thanks to the generosity of donors like you who funded the Summer Learning program. During the eight weeks of Summer Learning, children were engaged, entertained and educated about geology, music, art, and STEAM with programs around the theme of "Libraries Rock!"

The Library is here all year long, providing books, sensory toys, technology, and access to information. Some programs are designed to keep children active during the winter months, like Move and Groove and Winter Wonderland. Others teach new skills, such as gardening, art, and music appreciation. All programs highlight STEAM concepts to help children reach their potential in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics. **And you made it all happen.**

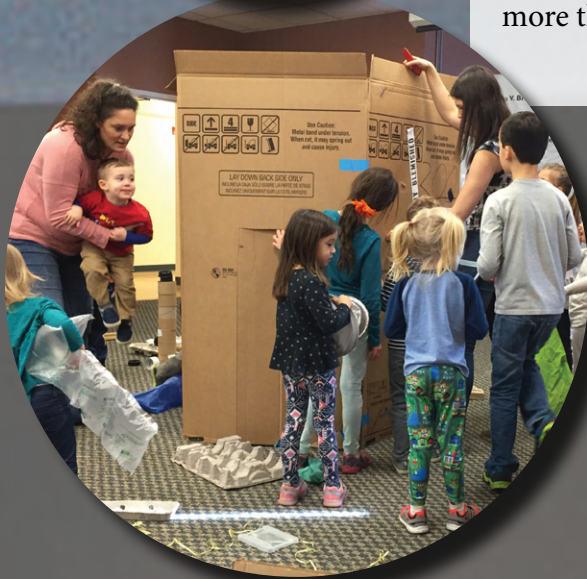


You made all of this happen providing access to books and information

Lifelong learning is a part of our mission, so we offer programs and resources for all ages – from books to audiobooks, movies and computer access and more – to help families learn together.

Enriching educational programs provide opportunities for people to learn, connect and grow. Adults can meet with others to talk about books, or attend a workshop to learn a new skill. We have so much to offer from computer classes, to history presentations, to crafting workshops. The Library offers a chance for adults to make social connections and explore the world.

In 2018 there were 270 programs for adults that were attended by more than 2,800 people. Our 36 public access computers were accessed nearly 24,000 times by adults who wanted to transform their lives by finding a new job or staying connected to family and friends. Inside the library, people accessed free Wi-Fi more than 80,000 times.

If you visit the James V. Brown Library today, you will notice a fresh new look in our Vintage building.

Updated furniture, carpeting and paint create a more comfortable, accessible, and safe environment for patrons of all ages. The design of a new sign on East Fourth Street harmonizes with the 1907 façade while its electronic message board draws attention to the activities inside.

New furniture in the Welch Children's Wing replaces the much-used original furniture with a warm and friendly new look.

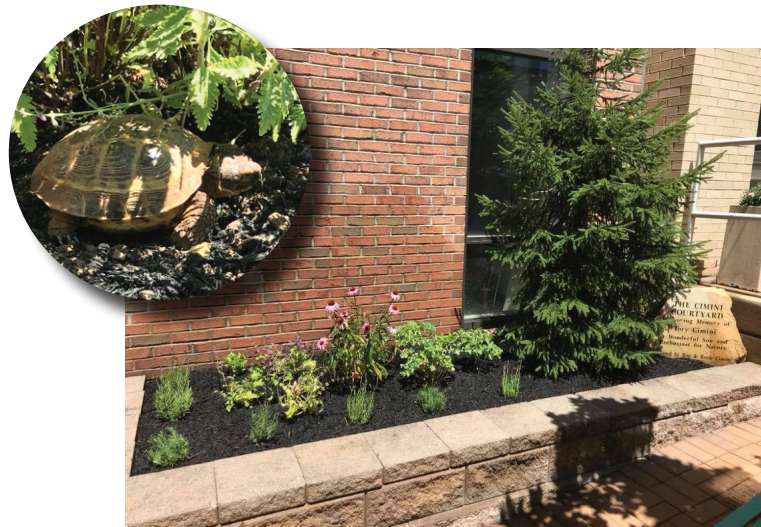

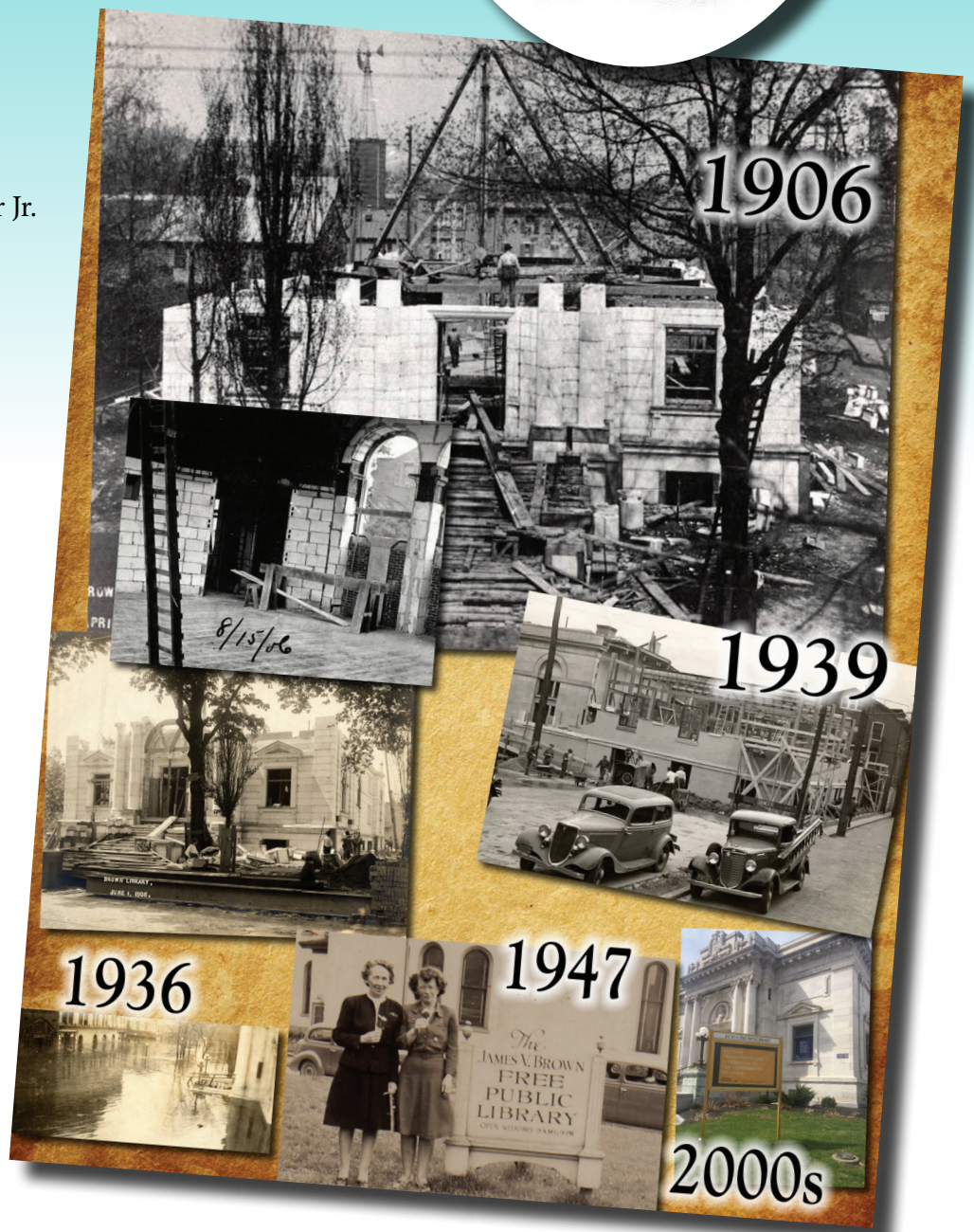
